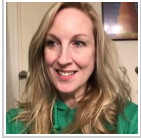
Steven was also loved by Scott & Karin Minnier, Max, Sydney and Ava of

In lieu of flowers, please consider donating to an organization in your community that serves underprivileged children and/or to children shamefully discarded by their family for being who they are.

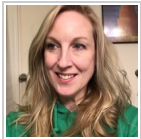

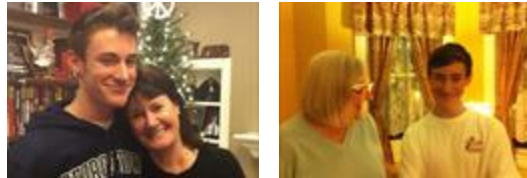
